

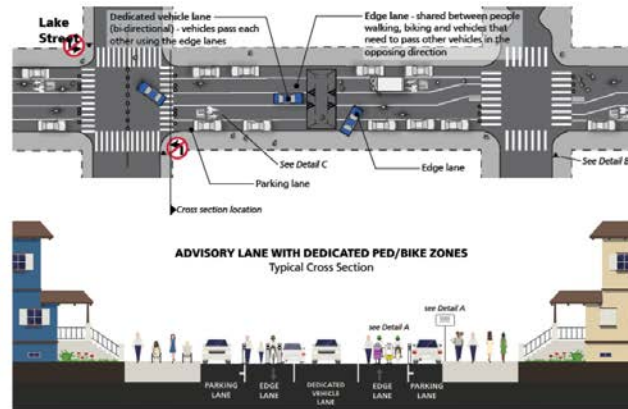

Proposal 1 - Slow Street with Advisory Lane and Dedicated Ped/Bike Zones



The Slow Street designation is maintained.

This configuration allows for two-way motor vehicle travel in a center lane, and also has two edge lanes for passing. The center lane is dedicated to and shared by, motorists traveling in both directions. Other users like pedestrians and bicyclists have the right-of-way in the edge lanes, but motorists can use the edge lanes, after yielding, to pass other vehicles traveling in the opposing direction. Pedestrians and people bicycling are not allowed in the dedicated vehicle lane (center lane). Vehicles loading or accessing buildings and parking spaces along the block may load in or use the edge lanes for access.

This design also proposes to include the following from the Slow Street post-pandemic design tool kit:

- **Speed humps** - on a majority of the blocks along Lake Street; final list of blocks will be included in the final design proposal for this option if it is supported
- **Median delineators** - added at targeted intersections - currently planned for Lake Street at 25th Avenue; but others may be considered in the final design proposal
- **Left-turn restrictions** - on 25th Avenue at Lake Street
- **Slow Streets pavement marking** - all blocks of Lake Slow Street
- **Slow Street wayfinding sign** - installed on all cross street along the Lake Slow Street extents
- **Upgrade all of the existing barricades to the new delineator barricade style**

Proposal 2 - Slow Street with No Roadway Striping



The Slow Streets designation is maintained.

Traffic stripes on the roadway are removed. Traffic striping helps assign roadway space, but streets without them, especially common and effective on shared roadways, creates ambiguity that forces drivers to drive more carefully. Traffic studies have shown that vehicle speeds tend to decrease after striping is removed, and increase, after striping is applied.

This design also proposes to include the following from the Slow Street post-pandemic design tool kit:

- **Speed humps** - on a majority of the blocks along Lake Street; final list of blocks will be included in the final design proposal for this option if it is supported
- **Median delineators** - added at targeted intersections - currently planned for Lake Street at 25th Avenue; but others may be considered in the final design proposal
- **Left-turn restrictions** - on 25th Avenue at Lake Street
- **Partial diverter/"cul-de-sac lite"** - added at targeted intersections - currently proposed on Lake Street at 25th Ave, 14th Ave, Funston Ave and 2nd Ave; but others may be considered in the final design proposal
- **Slow Streets pavement marking** - all blocks of Lake Slow Street
- **Slow Street wayfinding sign** - installed on all cross street along the Lake Slow Street extents
- **Upgrade all of the existing barricades to the new delineator barricade style**

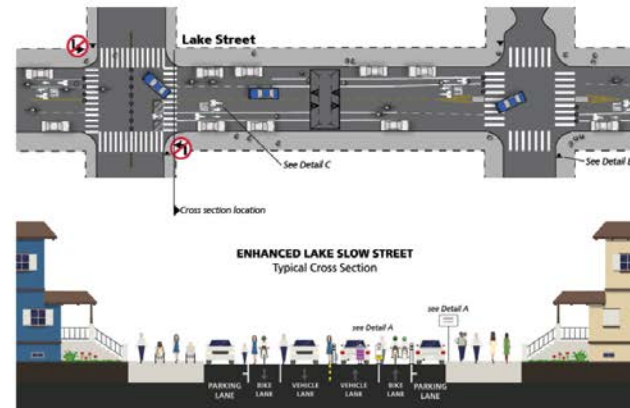

Proposal 3 - Enhanced Lake Slow Street



The Slow Streets designation is maintained.

This proposal maintains the existing Lake Slow Street and will also include the following design features to further improve traffic safety and user comfort. Treatments from the Slow Streets tool kit proposed include:

- **Speed humps** - on a majority of the blocks along Lake Street; final list of blocks will be included in the final design proposal for this option if it is supported
- **Median delineators** - added at targeted intersections - currently planned for Lake Street at 25th Avenue; but others may be considered in the final design proposal
- **Left-turn restrictions** - on 25th Avenue at Lake Street
- **Partial diverter/"cul-de-sac lite"** - added at targeted intersections - currently proposed on Lake Street at 25th Ave, 14th Ave, Funston Ave and 2nd Ave; but others may be considered in the final design proposal

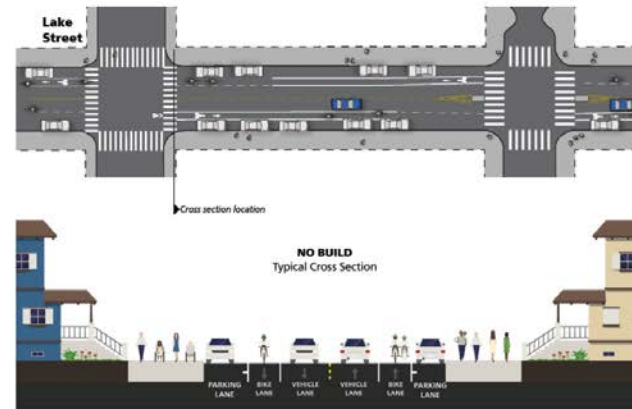
